## Core Values:

- 100% “seeing and believing” in others the way the Father does, and with the Father’s heart.
- 100% “working with” what the Spirit of God is prioritizing, and helping another engage God in that.
- 100% “having faith” in another to let them take full stewardship responsibility for their own lives.
- 100% “judgment-free” conversation zone by communicating from a posture of unconditional love and acceptance.

## Core Principles:

- Transformation is primarily experiential, not informational, occurring through real, everyday life experiences.
- Each person is a uniquely designed individual who is accountable for managing their own life.
- Authentic relationships are foundational to personal growth and successful living.
- Mental, emotional and spiritual maturity are the natural result of this kind of relational discipleship
